CHRISTMAS LUNCH AT BENNACHIE LODGE HOTEL, KEMNAY

Long Walk – Pitfichie Forest & Tillyfourie Quarry

Start at the car park for Pitfichie Forest NJ656132. Walk up the main track for a short distance before taking a forest path that will lead us to Tillyfourie Quarry and Hill. Here the main track is joined before joining another path to White Lady Hill (361m), Green Hill(399m) & Kings Moss. Descend from here down to the main track & back to the car park. For those that wish to go to the Xmas Lunch we drive to the Bennachie Lodge in Kemnay for 1pm

Total distance 11.7 km, Ascent 484m, Approx. 3 – 3.5 hrs. OS Map 37 & 38. Moderate fitness required.

Meet at St Peters Heritage Peterculter 8.15 am.

Sunday Saunter – Tillyfourie – A short walk on Donside

The walk starts at **10:00 am** from the car park at NJ655133 OS sheet 38 on a minor road just off the B993 at Tillyfourie. It's part of a Mack walk on good paths and forestry roads all the way round with details [here](#).

Total distance 5 km. Approx 2.0 hrs. Meet 10.00am at the car parking **NJ655133**
